Members Forum

An opportunity for our members to share their passion and expertise with others. Select club members present on a wide variety of topics of interest to our membership.

Monthly Presentations

Special guest speakers present on their photographic specialty. Some of the past topics included *Creativity in Lighting for Bird Photography, Using Photoshop to Make Better Images, and Making the Most of Focal Lengths and Ratios - Crop in Camera Not in the Computer.* Be sure to check the website for more information about the upcoming speakers and their topics.

Mentor Meetings

Whether you are new to photography or have some experience, we all face situations where it would be great to get advice from other photographers. The club offers a Mentorship Program to connect experienced photographers with less experienced ones. Whether you need help with a particular software program, your camera functions, artistic guidance or just understanding the process for competing each month, let us know your needs and we will connect you with a club photographer who has particular expertise in the area. Or if you are proficient in a specific area of photography, whether it's shooting or post-processing, and you'd like to be a mentor to newer photographers, join this group as a Mentor.

Club Outings

Group excursions with club members are a great way to improve your skills, experience new photographic locations, and meet new friends! The Chester County Camera Club offers a robust schedule of one or more outings per month. Previous destinations include Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge, Valley Preferred Cycle Center, Mt. Cuba Center, and Under and On the Ben Franklin Bridge. Club members also photographed the Chester County Balloon Festival, Sleepy Hollow MX Motocross, and scenes at Hawk Mountain. Club members are always willing to share their photo tips and participants may post their images from each outing on the website gallery for all to enjoy. Workshops

The club hosts several workshops each year, allowing members to get hands-on experience learning new skills and techniques. Recent workshops included Photography Using Lighting, Basics of Using PhotoPills Planner, and How to Use Textures in Post-Processing. Competitions

Each month, the Chester County Camera Club invites a highly qualified guest judge for the monthly competition. Entering images in contests, especially when they are themed, give you a chance to test your skills, expand your creativity, obtain constructive feedback, and fine-tune your skills.

Club Members can enter up to three photos in any category to see how their images rank against the other submissions. The rules for submissions are on the website at cccamerclub.org under the heading "Club Information" then click on "Competition Rules".

Print Critique Group – Members who are passionate about printing meet periodically (virtually or inperson) on weekends to share their prints and receive constructive comments.

Holiday and Annual Awards Parties – These events are always highly attended and provide even more opportunities to meet and socialize with your club members. The Holiday Party is held in December and the Annual Awards Party Is held in June.

Summer Challenge – A low-key way to stay active during the summer months, this challenge motivates members to keep creating images and sharing in a fun, group atmosphere.
